Vaughan Boom Lift Operator Training - A cherry picker is a kind of aerial work platform. Cherry pickers consist of a bucket or platform at the hydraulic lifting system's end. The machine is likewise called a boom lift, man lift, hydraladder or basket crane.

The bucket or platform is normally mounted on the back of a large motor vehicle like a truck, which is occasionally known as a bucket truck. A stand-alone trailer, self-moving platform or flat back pickup van could also be made use of. The worker stands within the bucket and works from there. The person inside the bucket normally has an upper set of controls enabling manipulation of the position of the bucket. The reach of the bucket could be extended on various models by telescoping to be able to adjust the lifting arm. Safety controls that are automatic prevent tipping. Articulated boom lifts are recommended for working within tight spaces or when it is necessary to clear obstacles.

Cherry pickers, as the name implies, were first made for picking fruit at high levels in trees. These devices are usually utilized in different industries such as exterior painting, construction and mining. Sometimes they are made use of for cleaning windows on high structures. The devices are utilized to service electrical equipment, telephone and cable television on utility poles. Fire fighters sometimes use cherry pickers, called snorkels, when ladders are not enough. At Christmas time, civic workers can be seen in cherry pickers hanging banners and lights.

## Boom Lift Operator Safety Training

Suggested training standards for safety awareness are set by local regulations. Program includes safe operation procedures through a combination of hands-on and classroom components.

Sessions consist of the following topics: general equipment safety factors; current regulations and applicable concerns; fall protection; features of boom lifts, different stationary work platform and scissor lifts.

Also included are the different responsibilities of the lift operator, like for example: function test procedure; workplace checks; avoiding and knowing dangers; equipment manufacturer's instructions and pre-operation check procedures.
