Vaughan Aerial Lift Training - The mechanized access platform called an aerial work platform is a machine that provides access to areas that are otherwise not accessible to people and other equipment. Also referred to as an aerial device or elevating work platform, the device is usually utilized to access high areas. Maintenance and construction employees usually should make use of aerial work platforms on the job. Firefighters use them for emergency access.

The aerial work platform is intended to temporary use, providing access to high areas. They are designed to be operated by one individual, with the capability of lifting weights of less than one ton. Several types have higher load limits. There are various kinds of aerial work platforms; like for instance, there is a "scissor lift" and a "cherry picker".

Some aerial work platforms come outfitted along with compressed air connectors for power tools or electrical outlets. For specialist tasks, like for example lifting frames for window glass, an aerial work platform may come with special tools.

Individuals who want to operate an aerial lift machine must go through training. Usually, the members of a Health & Safety Committee and their representatives are responsible for the inspection of each and every machine and work areas and are likewise required to undergo training. Those training will become familiar with how to utilize an aerial lift machine. They will also learn the regulations that apply to safely using these machinery. Rules vary in various provinces, and in federally regulated worksites.

Any worker who is required to be lifted by or work near an aerial lifting machine has to be told about potential dangers. In a general safety session, an Aerial Lift Training Video can be shown so as to educate all of the staff who are lifted by them or work near them.

Aerial Lift Training Program consists of modules focused on the following: Aerial Lift Devices and Operating Controls; Hazard Identification; Pre Operational Checks for Aerial Lift Devices; and Platform Positioning & Park Positioning. The program is meant to train workers on the safe operation of self-propelled, boom supported elevated work platform and self-propelled, elevated work platform. Employees who complete the program will be given a certificate, signed by a qualified individual to be able to verify the successful completion of a hands-on practical evaluation.
